

# Kitset for Webstore

We have now introduced the ability to sell kitset parent inventory items, both stocked and not stocked, as a standard Webstore feature. The feature inherits all of the component functionality already available within the Sales Order module, such as the ability to substitute components, change the quantity required for a component, adherence of mandatory components, thereby providing the same level of flexibility available within normal Greentree data entry.

Kitset component functionality is available within the following standard Webstore pages:

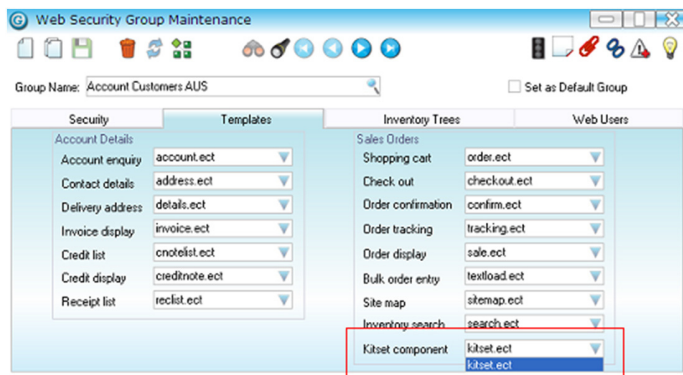
1. Catalogue
2. Inventory Search
3. Shopping Cart

## Web Security Group Maintenance

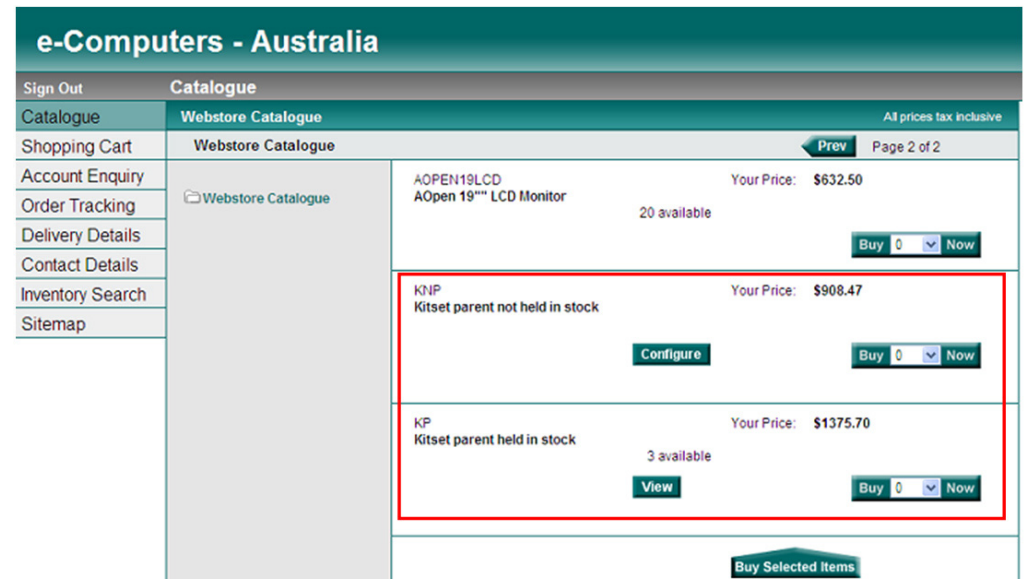
A new 'Kitset Component' template option has been added and must be selected in order for kitset functionality to be used. This template controls the application of kitset functionality within Webstore.



## Catalogue Page

Using the Webstore catalogue page as an example, inventory items which have been defined as being kitset parents, either held or not held in stock, can now be displayed where:

1. The **kitset component** template has been selected for the Web Security Group the web user belongs to
- AND
2. The parent item has been included within the nominated **tree branch** associated with the catalogue

# Kitset for Webstore

## Configure

The configure button is only available for **non-stocked kitsets** and launches the kitset component page, whereupon individual components may be maintained.

## View

The view button is only available for **stocked kitsets** and displays the kitset component page, whereupon individual components may be viewed but not maintained. In all other respects, the ordering of a stocked kitset parent item is the same as for a standard catalogue item

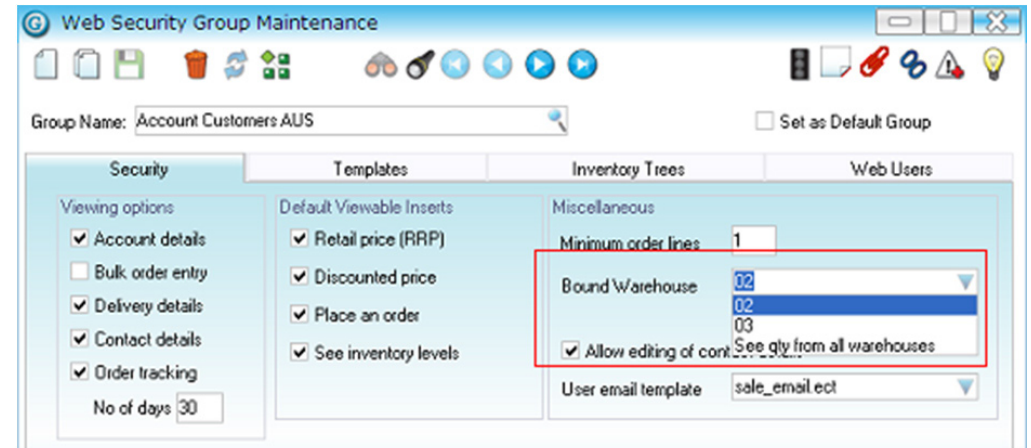
## Kitset Components Page

The components maintained against the kitset parent are displayed in the table below. Where the kitset parent is **not held** in stock, the page is in full **maintenance** mode. Navigation buttons to return the user to the catalogue, update the selling price or make a purchase are provided.

## Qty Available

The available quantity for each component is calculated according to the setting of the "bound warehouse" selection for the **Web Security User Group** to which the logged in user has been assigned. This is the same as for a standard catalogue inventory item.



## Update

This button can be used to **recalculate** the kitset **selling price** where component values have been changed from the standard values.

## Transaction Entry Edit Options

The following functionality is available within the component selection page and is controlled by making the relevant assignments against individual component items using the **Transaction Entry Edit Options** available within the Kitset Maintenance form.

# Kitset for Webstore

Selection of a substitute item will immediately display the relevant available quantity for the selected item.

### Changing the Quantity Required

Where allowed, the default quantity may be changed. To display the recalculated selling price for the kitset, use the <Update> button.

### Mandatory Component

Where a component has been assigned as being a mandatory part of the kitset, but a quantity change is also allowed, the user will not be able to change the quantity required to 0.00.

### Line Additions are not allowed

Note that although the ability to assign additional component lines to a kitset during transaction entry is an option available to be set against the kitset parent, it has not been made available as yet for Webstore kitset orders. Instead, should a standalone component be required by the user, they should make use of the Inventory Search facility to locate and select an individual catalogue item to add to the order.



### Substitute Components

Where the description text for a component is contained **within a combobox**, this means that substitute items have been maintained against the inventory item in Greentree and are available to be selected in place of the standard component displayed.
